Our Data Protection commitment

We are committed to managing your data securely and responsibly. Please refer to our General Data Protection Policy on our website, which details how we manage the processes required under the Data Protection Act.

Your data and third parties

We may use selected third parties to help deliver services to, and to support our council commitments to you or your organisation. Sometimes we are legally required to give information to certain authorised agencies but we will not share your data with any third parties for marketing or other purposes, unless you have told us that you are happy for us to do this. Note that we do not use third parties in different countries to support our activities. Again, if this changes we will always let you know and seek your permission.

Your rights

You have some important rights that determine how and whether we use your data.

Your privacy is extremely important to us so, if you think we are not handling your data properly we want you to tell us. And after that, if you feel that we are not getting it quite right, you can complain to the Information Commissioner www.ico.org.uk

Privacy Statement

Our Privacy Statement gives you the contact details of our organisation and explains who is who within it. It also advises the legal right under Data Protection (Article 6 (c) and (e) - GDPR) which entitles us to hold and use your information. At the same time, it explains why we need to do this.
